Where are you guys from?

Alex, Blake, Tim and I are from Mendham & Denzil is from Parsippany, New Jersey.

How long has the band been involved in the music industry?

We've all been involved in music for many years now and started since we were young, but we stepped onto the music scene together as a band about a year ago.

Can you tell the readers a little about the band?

X-Phaze is an unsigned indie rapper and a hip-hop/rock band (band name is the same as rapper name) with styles ranging from pop and reggae all the way to electronic and dance. Our age range is from 16-18 and we reside from all over Northern New Jersey. Only one year in the music business, X-Phaze has won Hot97's "Time 2 Shine" Contest, performed at the 2012 Bamboozle Music Festival, opened up for Rehab & Rittz, won WGIRL's "Battle of the Bands", and performed at the 2012 Miss Black USA pageant. "The "X" stands as an unknown and a variable; we are the unknown, the winners of the losers bracket, and the outcasts of the in-crowd. We are the variable that seems like it has no importance yet when the true meaning is discovered; it is in fact extremely powerful. The Phaze stands for the different phases we each have to encounter through our daily lives in order to give true meaning to the X. Therefore, we cannot be phased.

How do you describe your music and the band's sound?

Our sound is mainly hip-hop and rock but we also do a little electronic, funk, and reggae. Think of it as the Beastie Boys' music having a baby with Rage Against the Machine's music: we would be that baby.
